

# Basic Lace Assortment



**T**ransform intricate lace doilies into delicate gifts. Lace is a perfect background for ribbon embroidery and pin beading.

## Recipe

### Tree Angel Ornament

- 4" Wimpole Street Creations fine crochet doily
- 4" Wimpole Street Creations fabric and Battenburg round or square doily
- 6" Wimpole Street Creations fabric and Battenburg round or square doily
- One yard of 1/8" satin ribbon
- 3/4" styrofoam ball
- Beads or wired foil ribbon for halo
- Chenille needle
- Glue

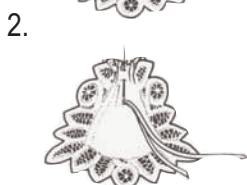
Fold down 1" of the lace and hand-baste with the ribbon along one edge of a square, or about 1/3 of the way around for a round doily (see diagram 1).

Tighten the ribbon and tie into a square knot and a bow, trim. Use the remaining ribbon to make a vertical stitch on the back slightly above the gathering stitches (see diagram 2). Pinch the small fabric and Battenburg doily together through the center for wings. Lay the wings over the vertical stitch and tie the ribbon into a square knot and a bow (see diagram 3).

Wrap the crochet doily around the styrofoam ball, glue and trim off the excess for the head (see diagram 4). Place the head, cut edges down, into the top of the gathered body and glue the head in place (see diagram 5). If using foil ribbon for the halo, wrap around a pencil, remove the pencil and twist the ends together (see diagram 6). Glue the halo to the head. Loop an 8" piece of ribbon under the wings for a hanger.

## Recipe

### Wedding Celebration Pillar

- One 6" three-wick candle
- One 6" Wimpole Street Creations fabric & Battenburg doily
- One 12" Wimpole Street Creations heavy crochet doily, optional
- 1/3 yard of 3/8" satin ribbon, optional
- One 5/8" brass heart charm, optional
- Photo copied on vellum paper
- 12" charger plate
- Silk greenery
- Low temp glue

Cut the fabric center from the fabric & Battenburg doily. Center and glue the photo in the doily frame and trim away the excess vellum. Position and glue the frame to the candle. NOTE: Apply the glue to the frame - not the candle. Tie the ribbon into a bow and glue to the frame. Glue the brass heart to the bow. Lay the 12" doily on the charger and place the candle on top of the doily. Arrange greenery around the candle.



## Recipe

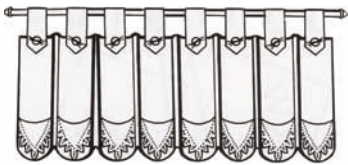
### Crayon Painting/Stamping/Stenciling

Draw or trace a small design in the center of a Wimpole Street Creations fabric and Battenburg or cutwork doily. Color the design with crayons. Place a white sheet of paper over the design area and press with an iron to set. The outline of the design can be embroidered with two strands of floss. Rubber stamps and stencils can also be used to decorate doilies.

### Coasters

Glue the wrong side of a 4" Wimpole Street Creations lace doily to a piece of contrasting wool felt. Carefully cut away the excess felt along the edges of the doily.

### Home Decor



Make a lacy edge on valances and curtains. Cut Wimpole Street Creations doilies in half diagonally and press the cut edge under 1/4". Overlap the edges of the doilies, and sew or glue in place.

## Recipe

### Ivy Bowl

- Wimpole Street Creations 8"-10" lace doily
- Small glass ivy bowl
- Ribbon
- Potpourri



Fill the ivy bowl with potpourri. Center the doily on top of the bowl and tie in place with the ribbon. Decorate as desired.
