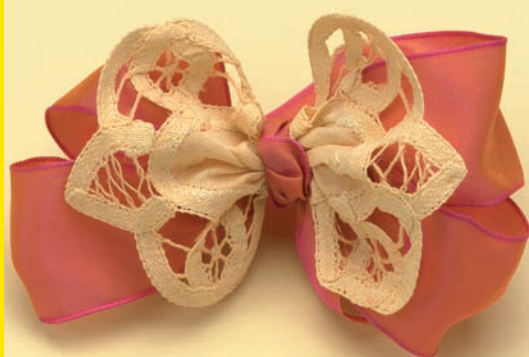


Dyed Doily Assortment



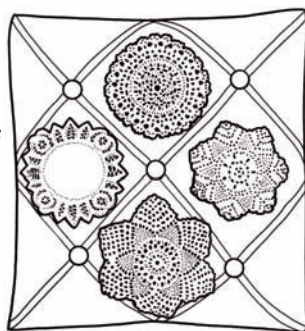
Lace doilies in assorted colors provide a mixture of country and pastel tones.

Recipe

Geometric Pillow

- Throw pillow (approx. 16" or 18" square)
- Four 4"-6" Wimpole Street Creations dyed doilies
- Three yards of 3/8"-5/8" grosgrain ribbon
- Five 7/8" buttons
- Fabric glue

Measure and mark with a pin, the center of each edge of the pillow front. Pin the ribbon between the marks on the diagonal and from corner to corner. Leave a 1/2" extension on each length of ribbon. Fold the ends of the ribbon under and glue in place. Repeat for all ribbons. Position and glue or hand-sew a doily in each square. Sew a button to each ribbon intersection.



Recipe

Hair Bow

- 4" Wimpole Street Creations dyed doily
- 24" of 7/8" satin ribbon
- Ribbon rose
- Barrette
- Thin floral wire
- Low temp glue



Make two double loops with the ribbon. Pinch the doily together through the center into small pleats and place on top of the ribbon. Wrap the wire tightly around the center of the ribbon and doily to secure. Decorate the hairbow with a ribbon rose or small crochet shape and glue to the barrette.

Dyed Doily Assortment

Recipe

Button Jar Pin Cushion

- Glass jar with lid
- Wimpole Street Creations 6"-8" round dyed doily
- Ribbon, torn fabric strips or raffia
- Polyester fiberfill
- Glue



Place a handful of fiberfill on top of the jar lid and glue in place. Center the doily over the fiberfill, adding more as needed to make a firm pin cushion. Pull the doily tight and glue to the lid. (NOTE: If your lace has large holes, you may wish to line it with a matching or coordinating fabric so the fiberfill does not come through.) Tie the ribbon around the lid and secure with a small amount of glue. Decorate as desired. Fill the jar with assorted buttons.

Recipe

Sachet & Potpourri Cone

- Two matching Wimpole Street Creations dyed doilies
- Narrow satin ribbon
- Chenille needle
- Glue
- Potpourri

Place the two doilies with wrong sides together. Hand-stitch around the edges of the lace with ribbon. Leave an opening in the top to fill with potpourri. Finish stitching around the lace. Knot the ribbon and tie into a bow. Decorate as desired . . . OR . . . roll a doily into a cone shape and glue together. Fill with potpourri or dried flowers. Attach a ribbon handle.



Recipe

Lace Roses

- Assorted 4"-6" round or heart-shaped Wimpole Street Creations dyed doilies
- Silk leaves
- Floral wire
- Floral tape



Fold the doily with wrong sides together. Fold the right edge on an angle (see diagram). Continue rolling and gathering the doily into a cone shape. Wrap the wire tightly around the base of the doily to secure, leaving a 6" - 8" tail. Add silk leaves and wrap the ends of the wire with floral tape. Curl back the edges of the lace to form rose petals.

Make a bouquet of flowers for a vase, or the flowers can be used to decorate hats, purses and gifts.
