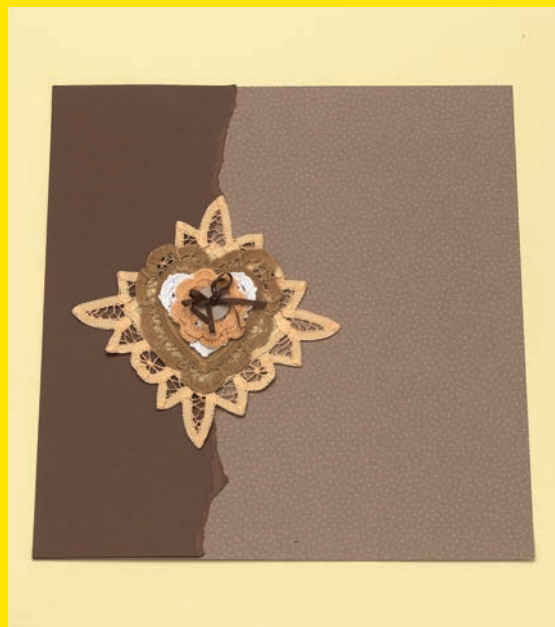


Dyed Doily Assortment



Lace doilies in assorted colors provide a mixture of country and pastel tones.

Recipe

Scrapbook Cover

- Make a collage on the cover of a scrapbook or notebook with Wimpole Street Creations assorted dyed doilies. Glue in place and decorate with treasured keepsakes such as ticket stubs, keys, ribbons from corsages, and postcards.



Picture Mat

- Cut the center from a dyed doily. Determine the placement of your picture and lightly mark along the outside edge. Put a small amount of glue on the wrong side around the outside edge of the lace, and glue in place. Trim as needed. Place in a picture frame.

Recipe

Stiffened Party Favor Cups

- Assorted round or square 4" Wimpole Street Creations dyed doilies
- 2" wide cylinder
- Glue stiffener (recipe below)

Dip the doilies in the stiffener and squeeze out the excess. Shape the doilies over the cylinder and allow to air dry. Decorate the cups and fill with treats.

Glue Stiffener

- 1 part craft glue
- 1 part water

Mix together to create a permanent finish with a plastic feel.

Recipe

Cell Phone or Eyeglass Case

- 4" - 6" Wimpole Street Creations dyed doily
- 6-1/2"x 7" piece of coordinating wool felt
- Glue
- Buttons or embellishments, optional
- Embroidery floss, optional
- Chenille needle, optional

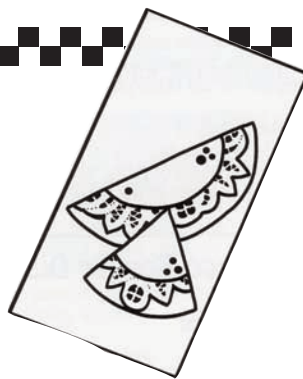


Randomly sew buttons, beads or pearls to the doily. Fold the felt in half to equal 3-1/4" x 7". Glue or blanket-stitch the side and bottom edges together. Wrap the embellished doily around the case and glue in place.

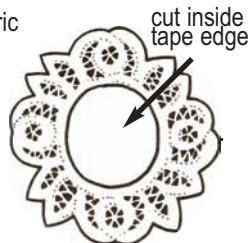
Recipe

Watermelon Applique' Dishtowel

- Wimpole Street Creations designer dishtowel
- 8" square of burgundy fabric
- 6" round Wimpole Street Creations dyed hunter green doily
- 1/4 yard of fusible web
- Seven 3/8" black buttons
- Matching thread



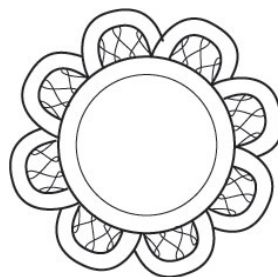
1. Iron the fusible web to the wrong side of the dyed doily and burgundy fabric following manufacturer's instructions.
2. Trim inside the lace edges of the doily. Use the burgundy fabric for the watermelon and the green lace edges for the rind.
3. Remove the paper backing from the pieces. Layer and cut into a half slice and two wedges. Position the pieces on the dishtowel and fuse in place.
4. Machine-stitch around the watermelon pieces. Hand-stitch the buttons to the watermelon for seeds.



Recipe

Coasters

- 4" round Wimpole Street Creations dyed fabric and Battenburg doilies
- Coordinating wool felt
- Craft glue



Glue the wrong side of the doilies to a piece of wool felt. Carefully cut away the excess felt along the edges of the doilies.
