Yo-Yo Heart Ornament

For each heart you will need:

- Two *Wimpole Street* 4" fabric & Battenburg doilies
- 6"x 12" piece of a *Wimpole Street* dishtowel or fabric
- *Wimpole Street* 5" dyed fabric and Battenburg holly (optional)
- *Wimpole Street* yo-yo
- 3/4" button, or three small red buttons
- One yard of coordinating embroidery floss
- Polyester fiberfil
- Matching thread

Cut two heart pieces on the bias from the dishtowel fabric, using the pattern provided (increase pattern by 200%). Machine-stitch the hearts together, leaving an opening as indicated on the pattern. Clip the curved edges, turn right side out and press. Stuff the heart with fiberfill and slip-stitch the opening closed.

Pin the doily to the stuffed heart. Center the yo-yo then the button on the doily and hand-stitch through the heart with six strands of floss. Tie the floss on top of the button.

Thread a 6" piece of floss through the top for a hanger.

VARIATION: Cut holly into separate leaves and glue at the top of the heart. Cluster the red buttons in the center of the stems for berries.
